Early Dismissals for Parent-Teacher Conferences Wednesday October 10th and Thursday October 11th



All students will be dismissed at 2:00 p.m.

Parent-Teacher conferences are scheduled for Wednesday, October 10th and Thursday, October 11th. These conferences provide parents and teachers with an opportunity to discuss your child. As this is the first formal interview of the school year, **teachers** are interested to hear about your child from you, their parents. We are expecting all parents to attend these conferences as they are important and will help us to establish a good working relationship with parents.

The process for booking appointments will be on-line through Parent Connect. You do not call in for an appointment. Instructions have been sent home this week. The link found on Parent Connect is now active until noon on Thursday, October 11th. Book early to avoid disappointment!

We want to connect with you.

Each year we are required to have three formal report cards (Dec., March and June) as well as two informal reports to parents. These interviews are considered an informal report. If you are not able to come in on either of these dates, we ask that you contact the teacher(s) and set another appointment time or conduct your interview on the phone at a mutually agreed upon time



Emergency Preparedness

This month we will be focusing some of our attention on our school's Emergency Preparedness plans. This will include a fire drill and an Earthquake drill. We will ONLY be including

the classroom portion of the Earthquake drill, which includes being aware of and checking for hazards around the room. The drop-cover-hold drill will be explained to the students and practiced as well. We are required to have three Earthquake drills each year. Later in the school year (likely in May) we will extend the drill to include a full student release. In the event of an emergency, a full scale Emergency Release protocol is in place. Parents are asked to bring ID and wait as we record the name of the parent picking up. If someone other than a parent comes to pick up a child, they must be on the Emergency Release section of Parent Connect. They will need to wait in line at a central release station, show ID, and then the child will be released to them. It is very important that all parents review the information currently on Parent Connect for each of their children. Please note that that your Emergency Contact is not the same as a designated Emergency Release.



Lost and Found

It is very important that all of your child's belongings (jackets, gym clothes, boots, shoes, etc.) be labelled with their name. We will make every effort to check for this before placing items in our Lost and Found area. Our Lost and Found is located in the hallway by the gym. If your child is missing something, please come have a look!

Halloween Costumes

<u>Wednesday</u>, October 31st, students are invited to wear costumes. All students need to remember a couple of guidelines for school costumes. These are: **no replica**



weapons may be brought to school even if they are part of a costume and please ensure that your child's costume is appropriate for regular classroom work (not too revealing, no masks in class). Try to keep it simple and save elaborate costumes for the evening activities. Please label all parts of your child's costume. The costume parade will be starting at 1:15pm. Students will "follow the leader" around the hallways and come through the Gym as well. Parents may come to the Gym to watch the parade.
