Reminders for Parents:

Kindergarten Registration for McCloskey begins February 12th (9-12:00 in the Library)

A child may be registered to attend Kindergarten in September 2019 if they were born in 2014.

At the time of registration, the following original documents must be provided:

- 1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport).
- 2. Proof of citizenship for both the parent and the student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card).
- 3. Card Card, medical and emergency contact information.
- Proof of Address showing address (property taxes- current receipt, purchase or rental agreement or rental receipt).
