<u>GRADES 1-7: (9:00 a.m.)</u> Students line up at last year's pod door and return to their last year's class for the morning instructions and the important task of determining our enrolment. Last year's Kindergarten students will be working with teachers other than their last year's teachers.

DISMISSAL TIME is 12:00, NOON. THERE WILL BE NO AFTERNOON CLASSES.
